

# Garbage collection schedule in Ikoma City

Collection dates are different depending on the region. **Please check the Japanese version.**

<b>Twice a week</b> Please check the Japanese version for exact collection days. Combustible garbage is collected even on national holidays. However, garbage will not be collected on certain dates. Please check the Japanese version for dates.	<b>Combustible garbage</b> (designated paid bags) <b>Charged</b> (transparent/semi-transparent bags) <b>Free of charge</b>	Please take to the combustible garbage collection site. Please take garbage to the collection site <b>by 7:00 a.m.</b> on the collection day. (Garbage is collected sequentially from 7:00 a.m.)	Kitchen waste  Please drain water completely. Plastic products  Toys Containers Unclean plastic containers and packages  Only garbage that does <b>not exceed 30 cm</b> can be disposed. Unclean cloths, shoes, paper scraps, tissues, rubber, etc.

If you cannot use the group resource collection, take the following garbage to the combustible garbage collection site separately. Either bundle the garbage with string or use a separate bag and dispose of each item individually. Do not take these out on a rainy day.
<b>Once a week</b> Please check the Japanese version for the day. Plastics are collected even on national holidays. However, plastics will not be collected on certain dates. Please check the Japanese version for dates. *Plastics = plastic containers and packages	<b>Plastic Containers and Packages</b> (transparent/semi-transparent bags) <b>Free of charge</b>		<b>Containers and packages with the “♻️” mark</b> <b>[Plastics are not accepted]</b> Plastic shopping bags Food packages Cups Packages Food trays, polystyrene foam Bottles <b>Unclean items</b> Rinse items lightly, remove droplets or wipe them off. <b>Items that cannot be cleaned</b> Take them to the collection site as combustible garbage.
<b>Twice a month</b> Please check the Japanese version for dates.	<b>Small Appliances and Metals</b> <b>Glass bottles and cans</b> <b>PET bottles</b> <b>Fragile items</b> <b>Toxic wastes</b> (transparent/semi-transparent bags) <b>Free of charge</b>	Please take to the recyclable garbage collection site.	<b>If an item does not fit in the bag, it must follow the “Oversized Electrical Appliances and Metals” described below. Televisions and other items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Act and computer monitors are not accepted.</b> Small metals and small electrical appliances that <b>fit in bags up to 45 L</b> can be placed in the same bag. Umbrellas should not be placed in bags but directly in the collection area. If you have multiple umbrellas, please tie them together. Batteries should be <b>removed</b> and disposed of as toxic waste.
			Put glass bottles and cans that contained beverages and food, bottles for cosmetics and spray cans into the same bag. Empty cans  Snack cans  Food bottles and jars Empty and rinse bottles and cans with water. (Please remove caps before disposal.) Plastic PET bottles with the “♻️” mark  PET (1) Remove the cap. (2) Remove the label. (3) Rinse bottles with water. Take out caps and labels to the collection site as plastic packages. * Cap rings can be left as they are. * Do not put other garbage into the PET bottle bag. * They can also be crushed and taken out.
			<b>[Ceramic ware (pottery)]</b> Tea cup Dishes and bowls <b>[Glass products]</b> Glass Glass Cups Ceramics and glassware should be placed in <b>separate bags</b> (no larger than 45 L). Unbroken tableware is also accepted at the unattended collection containers at the North Community Center ISTA Habataki and the South Community Center Seseragi.
			<b>[Batteries, Mercury thermometers]</b> Rechargeable batteries (lithium-ion batteries) can be disposed. <b>[Mirrors]</b> <b>[Fluorescent lights and bulbs]</b> Put "batteries and thermometers", "mirrors", and "fluorescent lights and bulbs" in <b>separate bags</b> . Put LED bulbs with small electric appliances

The following types of waste are not accepted at collection points. You must book a collection. Online booking requires a phone request for the initial time only. To contact us, please ask a person who can speak Japanese.

<b>Oversized garbage Non-combustible</b> <b>Charged</b>	<b>[Items that fit in the designated bags]</b> No bulky waste disposal tickets required Sort them into burnable and non-burnable items, place them in the specified bags, tie them shut, and affix a piece of paper to each bag with the receipt number. Burnable (over 30 cm) Non-burnable	<b>[Items that don't fit in the designated bag]</b> Attach the "oversized garbage disposal ticket" on each item. Oversized garbage disposal tickets are available at specified shops. Oversized garbage disposal ticket	You will be told the collection date when you make a request.
	<b>Oversized Electrical appliances Metals</b> <b>Free of charge</b>	<b>[Electrical appliances and metals that do not fit into clear or semi-transparent bags up to 45 L]</b> No bulky waste disposal tickets required Attach a piece of paper with your receipt number on it. 	

**Separate and put out garbage on the designated collection date!!**
